Notre Dame House & Community Resource Centre

Youth face many challenges on their journey to adulthood. When confronted with abuse, neglect and homelessness, they are at risk of becoming stuck in an inescapable cycle of poverty. Good Shepherd Youth Services is always ready to welcome them.

Notre Dame House, located in downtown Hamilton, is a co-ed emergency shelter for homeless and street-involved youth from 16 to 21 years of age.

Through the **Notre Dame Community Resource Centre**, at-risk youth have access to a variety of outreach support services – and they don't need to be staying at Notre Dame House to use them. The services include support, counselling and advocacy to help the youths transition to a more stable lifestyle.

Notre Dame House School

Notre Dame House School, an alternative learning environment operated in partnership with the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board, helps to break barriers for students who are affected by homelessness, poverty, family breakdown and mental illness. Students can attend the school for a brief period then reintegrate into a mainstream high school, or they can complete their high school credits at Notre Dame House School. Good Shepherd hosts an annual graduation ceremony for students who have earned their high school diploma.
