Personal Support Workers (PSW) Part Time [1] and Relief Positions

Emmanuel House Hospice is a ten-bed palliative care facility located in Hamilton that offers a homelike environment for individuals who are nearing the end of their lives. Support and care are provided in a team-based approach, including various interdisciplinary team members such as personal support workers, nursing, physicians, spiritual and psychosocial support. We embrace a holistic model of care and the importance of providing individuals dignity at the end of their life, while providing opportunity for the resident and family to exercise religious, cultural and spiritual rituals, customs, rites and beliefs.

Position Requirements:

- PSW certificate, in good standing from an approved and recognized institution
- Current CPR and First Aid certificate is required
- Experience working with individuals in the end of life or with a life limiting illness
- Previous work experience providing care to persons at the end of life clients, their families and friends.
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively within the care team
- Ability to deliver care in a person-centered way that considers the resident's personal and cultural needs/preferences
- Good judgement, problem-solving and assessment skills
- Enhanced training in palliative/end of life care, such as Fundamentals in Hospice Palliative Care considered an asset.
- Excellent attendance record
- Must be available to work a 12-hour shift schedule that includes days and nights.
- Ability to speak French and/or other languages considered an asset.
