The Cathedral Overflow program is a temporary emergency overflow shelter that supports women, trans and non-binary individuals who are or may be experiencing homelessness, mental health, substance use, abuse and poverty. The program supports individuals in developing individualized personal care plans to achieve self-directed goals and to obtain safe, affordable permanent housing outcomes.

The successful candidate will extend our mission to residential clients through the provision of basic needs, resource and administrative functions. This may include providing basic necessities, answering inquiries, supporting with meals and preparing units for intake. The incumbent must be able to work in a challenging, fast-paced and rewarding values-based environment.

Applicants should possess knowledge of issues impacting women including abuse, mental illness, homelessness, poverty and substance use. A demonstrated commitment to the mission values of availability, responsibility, adaptability, quality and dignity is essential. Applicants will have initiated post-secondary education or have a combination of post-secondary education and experience. The successful candidate will have a flexible schedule. Women of diverse communities are encouraged to apply.
