We are seeking a **Foot Care Nurse (RN or RPN)** for a 3 months contract position (possibility of contract extension) in Hamilton. This position is largely Monday-Friday however there will be the occasional need for flexibility in hours and/or weekends.

Position responsibilities include:

- Provide Foot and/or hand care to Seniors in the Community
- Understand and implement infection prevention while specifically adhering to care standards as it relates to foot care and general health
- Build relationships while working one on one with clients
- Provide exceptional care by utilizing well developed skills of observation, assessment, nursing diagnosis and counseling
- Develop a care-plan based on assessments, health and directives from physicians
- Teach and educate on foot-related topics, promote client-directed care, self-care and independence

The successful candidate must possess:

- Diploma in Nursing (either RN or RPN)
- Currently registered and in good standing with CNO
- Have completed or willing to complete Foot Care Certification
- Current certification in First Aid/CPR
- A strong desire to help improve the lives of Seniors in our community
- At least one-year experience working with seniors
- Knowledge and experience preferable for those who have worked with Seniors. persons with dementia, diabetes, mental health or multiple health issues
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Strong verbal communication skills
- Ability to work effectively with other staff, students and volunteers as an effective member of an interdisciplinary team

- Adhere to working and operating within an anti-racism and anti-oppression framework
- A demonstrated commitment to the mission values of availability, flexibility, adaptability, hospitality and dignity is essential
- Fluency in French or a second language considered an asset
